ORDINANCE NO. 10-21

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WESTON LAKES, TEXAS, APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE CITY'S ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2021 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2022; MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CITY AS REFLECTED IN THE BUDGET; MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS; AND CONTAINING OTHER PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE SUBJECT.

WHEREAS, the Mayor filed with the City Secretary a proposed budget for the City's fiscal year, beginning on October 1, 2021 and ending on September 30, 2022 ("FY2021-22");

WHEREAS, the proposed FY2021-22 budget was prepared in compliance with Chapter 102 of the Texas Local Government Code, and included the City's proposed expenditures and expected revenues to cover the budget for FY2021-22;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the action of the City Council, and after notice was published as required by law, a public hearing on the proposed FY2021-22 budget was held by City Council at 32611 FM 1093, Weston Lakes, Texas 77441 on the 28th day of September 2021, at which all citizens of the City had the right to be present and to be heard and those who requested to be heard were heard;

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the proposed FY2021-22 budget and has made such changes as in the City Council's judgment are warranted by law and are in the best interest of the citizens and taxpayers of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council now desires to approve and adopt as the City's FY2021-22 budget, the document attached to this Ordinance as Exhibit "A"

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTON LAKES, TEXAS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The facts and recitations set forth in the preamble of this Ordinance are hereby found to be true and correct.

<u>Section 2</u>. The City Council hereby approves and adopts, as the budget for the City's fiscal year beginning October 1, 2021 and ending September 30, 2022, the document attached to, and made a part of, this ordinance as Exhibit "A" (the "FY2021-22 Budget").

Section 3. The City Secretary is hereby directed to place on said budget an endorsement which shall be signed by the City Secretary, which shall read as follows: "The Original General Budget of the City of Weston Lakes, Texas, for the Year 2021-2022". Such budget, as thus endorsed, shall be kept on file in the office of the City Secretary as a public record and posted on the City's official website required by section 102.008(a)(2) of the Texas Local Government Code.

<u>Section 4.</u> In support of said budget and by virtue of the adoption thereof, including any and all changes adopted thereto, the several amounts

specified for the various purposes named in said budget are hereby appropriated to and for such purposes.

Section 5. In the event any clause phrase, provision, sentence, or part of this Ordinance or the application of the same to any person or circumstances shall for any reason be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect, impair, or invalidate this Ordinance as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part declared to be invalid or unconstitutional; and the City Council of the City of Weston Lakes, Texas, declares that it would have passed each and every part of the same notwithstanding the omission of any such part thus declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, whether there be one or more parts.

<u>Section 6.</u> All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent or in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such inconsistency or conflict, hereby repealed.

Section 7. That it is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this ordinance is passed is open to the public as required by law, and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required.
